

Q(UICK) TIPS

Be a cleaning machine with your cleaning machines. Dishwashers can get impossibly dirty and stained with things like coffee, sauces and water spots.

Clean the inside of your dishwasher by place one cup of plain white distilled vinegar in a container on the bottom rack and a half-cup of baking soda into a small dish and place on the top rack. Run the dishwasher on the hottest setting, and let the vinegar and baking soda work their magic. Once the dishwasher has run through the cycle, let it sit closed for 20 minutes and continue to steam clean. Then, wipe the inside with a paper towel or soft sponge until dry.
